Fire Precautions (Workplace) Regulations 1997
(Provisions to be provided for raising the alarm in case of fire)

The Alarm Box is a maintenance free unit, needing only a weekly test to ensure the batteries are charged. Keeping a record of testing and battery changes, the same as with any mains backup system, is recommended. If copper top batteries are fitted, they will last at least three months.

The Break Glass can be re-set with the key provided.

The Alarm Box can stand alone or be linked to other boxes. If it is in a linked system and batteries are not fitted, it can be used the same as a call point. It will operate the nearest box with batteries.

The shower-proof Alarm Box is intended to replace rotary hand bells. The system is currently installed in a variety of locations and is suitable for construction sites, small workshops, portacabins or any small building that does not require a full mains battery back-up system.

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Additional Information

- i** The alarm box is a maintenance free unit.
- i** It should be tested weekly to ensure that the batteries are OK.
- i** If used as directed, ordinary “copper-top” batteries should last for up to 1 year.
- i** A test record and log of battery changes should be kept in the same manner as for any mains battery backup system
- i** The Break Glass is resettable using the key supplied.
- i** These units can be used in a standalone, or linked configuration

- ✓ Any small building that does not require a full mains battery backup system.

 - * 1x Fire Action Sign
 - * 2x EN3 Identification Signs
 - * 2x Brackets
- i** Option 2: Lease
 - Equipment supplied as per Option 1, but with these additional benefits:
 - * Siting of fire points
 - * Linking of fire points
 - * Regular Testing and servicing of fire points
 - * Removal of fire points at handover stage
 - * Battery renewal as required
 - * Storage of fire points when not in use
